40 DAYS FOR LIFE - SPRING CAMPAIGN - a great Lenten opportunity! The 40 Days for Life Spring Campaign runs Ash Wednesday, February 18 to Palm Sunday, March 29. As you probably know, the abortion facility on Old Georgetown Road in Bethesda has closed. We supported a prayer vigil there for many years. The clinic moved to 5454 Wisconsin Avenue, Chevy Chase, MD, 13th floor. It is called CARE Reproductive Health, LLC and is still performing late term abortions. All are invited to come and pray at the abortion facility on Saturdays at 10 am. We would like to have more HR parishioners show up to pray outside the facility at other times as well.
